

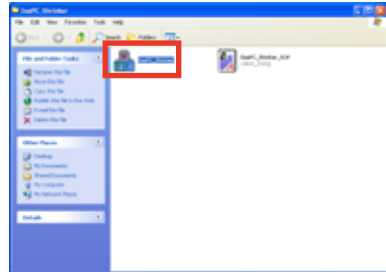
Eee PC Shrinker

Eee PC Shrinker is designed to clean up unnecessary temporary files produced by Windows programs, remove programs that have similar functions, and disable system functions that occupy too much drive space, providing more space for your system drive.

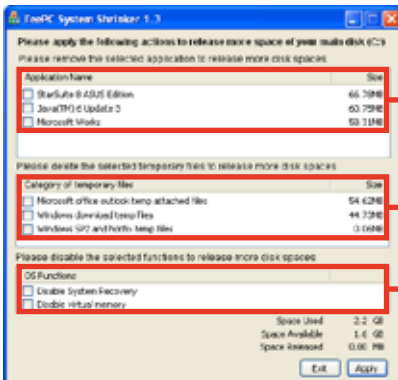


Using Eee PC Shrinker might cause data lose or damage. We recommend that you make a backup of your important files before continuing to the following procedures.

1. Unzip **EeePC Shrinker.zip** and double-click **EeePC Shrinker.exe**.



2. Eee PC Shrinker lists all temporary files, programs and OS functions. Select the files to delete or the OS function to disable and click **Apply**.



Select the program you want to uninstall.

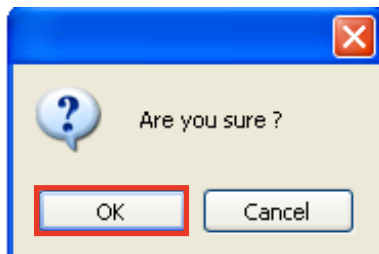
Select the temporary files you want to delete.

Select the OS functions you want to disable.

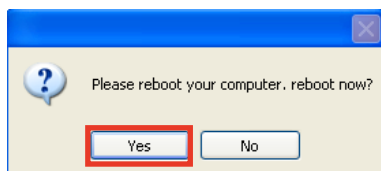


The **StarSuite** (or **Star Office**), **JAVA** and **Microsoft Works** items appear only if you have Microsoft Office 2000/2003/XP/2007 installed in your Eee PC.

3. Eee PC Shrinker starts cleaning after clicking **OK**.



4. Click **Yes** to reboot your computer after system cleaning.



You can manually enable the system recovery and virtual memory functions if in need.

To enable virtual memory

1. Right-click **My Computer** and click **Properties**.
2. In the **System Properties** dialog box, click the **Advanced** tab and click **Settings** in the **Performance** area. Click the **Advanced** tab, and then click **Change** in the **Virtual memory** area.
3. In the Virtual Memory dialog box, enter the custom virtual memory size, click **Set**, and then click **OK**.

To enable system recovery

1. Right-click **My Computer** and click **Properties**.
2. In the **System Properties** dialog box, click the **System Restore** tab, and then click to clear the **Turn off System Restore on all drives** check box. Click **OK** to finish.
